The Wabash County Council held its first meeting of 2005 at 8:00 A.M. on January 24th, in the former Circuit Court room of the Courthouse. Wabash County Auditor, Jane Ridgeway called the organizational meeting to order with all members present.

The first order of business was election of officers for the year 2005. Ted Little nominated Paul Sites for Council Chairman, seconded by Bob Fuller. Sites was elected by a 7-0 vote. Nominations were then opened for Vice Chairman and Ted Little nominated Leon Ridenour, seconded by Gary Nose. Ridenour was elected by a 7-0 vote also.

Prayer was offered by Leon Ridenour. Minutes of the December 6, 2004 meeting were reviewed. With the correction noted, Ridenour moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Little, and approved 7-0.
