Requested to purchase a new computer Financial Accounting program to replace the old ATEK/Marathon/Harris system running on the outdated VAX operating system. A new windows based program will update the Auditor's Office financial accounting and reporting, payroll operations and the Treasurer's fund accounts. It would be desirable to purchase a new system as soon as possible in order to be ready to start on the new system for the new calendar year January 1, 2006.

Following a review of four software company programs for financials, discussion by the Auditor and IT Consultant Thomas Polk of Wabash Electric Information Technology and the recommendation of the Board of Commissioners, it was decided to approve the funding to purchase Kintera FundWare Financial Accounting system. A motion to approve \$90,000 from the County General Fund- Auditor's Budget was made by Bergman, seconded by Little and approved by a 7-0 vote.

Presented to the Wabash County Council, read in full and tabled on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October and the 5<sup>th</sup> of December; presented again to the Wabash County Council, read in full and adopted on the 20<sup>th</sup> of December 2005. After giving careful consideration by all members present, and upon proper motion and second and by unanimous vote, the County Council made the recommendation as indicated on the various pages of the Additional Appropriation. The Auditor was directed to present the above additional appropriations to the Department of Local Government Finance for approval as by law provided.

Bergman moved to approve Transfer Resolution #17; this motion was seconded by Ridenour and approved by a 7-0 vote.

Commissioners Les Templin, Brian Haupert and Darle Dawes presented to the Council the need to replace the current postage meter in the courthouse due to the new postage rates and the out-dated equipment. They have recommended leasing a new Hasler Postage Meter from Impac and this must be done immediately to be in compliance with the new postage rates. Also they discussed the Prosecutor's need for new office equipment and furniture following the move to his new office in Memorial Hall, he will be presenting a request to the Council to be paid from Pre-Trial Diversion and Title IV-D Funds in January and they (the Commissioners) have approved this request not to exceed \$50,000. Also on the agenda for repairs for the new year will be Emergency Roof Repairs on the Courthouse Roof to be paid from the Cumulative Capital Development Fund.

The Commissioners reported they have received both of the Ambulance study reports and will be sending a copy to the Council members for review. It was decided to have all council members remain on the appointed boards they are currently serving until further discussion and appointments in the new year. Ridenour was requested to continue serving on the Convention and Visitors Bureau board.

No other business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Little, seconded by Fuller and a 7-0 vote. The next meeting will be a reorganization meeting on January 23, 2005. The council will meet on the second floor of the Wabash County Courthouse at 8:00 A.M.
