WABASH COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The Wabash County Council met in session on Monday, October 18, 2021 in the Commissioner's meeting room of the Wabash County Courthouse. Chairman Kyle Bowman called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. Council members present: Bowman, Matthew Mize, Sam Hann, Matt Dillon, Barbara Pearson, and Philip Dale. Lorissa Sweet was absent. Bowman opened with a word of prayer and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The proceedings of the meeting were recorded by the County Auditor Marcie Shepherd.

Chairman Bowman requested that those present silence their cell phones and stated that all public comments regarding agenda and non-agenda items are permitted and encouraged.

The first order of business was to approve the minutes of the September 20, 2021 Council meeting. Hann made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Dale seconded the motion and it passed by a 5-0 vote; Dillon arrived after the vote.

Connie Neininger with Hoosiers for Renewables gave a presentation entitled "Indiana Grows with Renewable Energy." If Wabash County would like to see examples of the paperwork needed, White County has completed the process. Cheryl Ross expressed concerns regarding fires with the batteries. Next on the agenda was a Public Hearing regarding on additional appropriation not to excel \$350,000 for a lease between Wabash County and non-profit Jail Building Corporation. Steve Downs, Wabash County Attorney, went over the additional appropriation. The funds to meet this appropriation are to be provided by the sale of certain real estate from the County to the Wabash County Jail Building Corporation. Dale made a motion to close the public hearing, Dillon seconded; it passed by a 6-0 vote. Dillon made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2021-85-16 Appropriation Ordinance financing of the project through the Building Corporation, Hann seconded; it passed by a 6-0 vote.

Keith Gillenwater, Grow Wabash County CEO, along with Sam Krouse of Midwest Poultry Services; presented an abatement proposal for Midwest Poultry Services LP. MPS Eggs proposes to open a new facility adjacent to its Hi-Grade farm. The new facility will produce a Kipster egg. Kipster eggs are notable due to their low-to-nocarbon production techniques. This Kipster egg site will be the first of its kind in the United States. Dillon made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2021-21-17 A Tax Abatement on Real and Personal property for ten (10) years, Dale seconded the motion; it passed by a 5-0-1 vote. Mize abstained due to conflict of interest.

RESOLUTION: Dillon would like the Council to make a statement in regards to the Federal Mandate on COVID Vaccine and testing. Although this will have no legal standing, he feels he needs to make the statement in support of the small businesses. He said that although we acknowledge that vaccines have helped protect millions of Americans, he does oppose the government trying to mandate such treatment. Dillon also stated that OSHA would not be justified under the current circumstances. Hann stated he agrees with the statements made and would support a resolution. Pearson said she feels that it takes more courage to stand up for what we believe in rather than sit back and let things go. so she supports doing a resolution.

Dale said he agrees with the points, but feels that the council is a fiscal body and should not make a statement.

Mize supports the statement, feels that the employers should be able to make the decisions on employment.

Bowman feels that a statement would show support of the local businesses to make these decisions.

County Attorney Steve Downs would like to add language to balance the resolution to give the statement that they want and still encourage residents to get the vaccine.

Auditor Shepherd informed the council that Ryan Burke with the DLGF said that it looks as though the county is under the max levy by about \$395,000 due to a calculation error. If the county would like, there is still time to re-adopt the budget before the October 31, 2021 deadline. In order to do this, the council must rescind the

adopted budget, change the budget as needed and adopt the new budget. Dillon made a motion to rescind Ordinance Number 2021-85-13 of the 2022 Approved Budget. Dale seconded the motion; it passed by a 6-0 vote.

Bowman proposed to add a Bond payment and move items back into the general fund that were moved into another fund that could not be used for that. Dillion made a motion to approve Budget Ordinance 2021-85-13 as amended, Dale seconded the motion; it passed by a 6-0 vote.
